EPA Victoria Works Approval update

Australian Paper's Energy from Waste (EfW) Works Approval Application to EPA Victoria is an important step in our \$7.5 million feasibility study. This process has provided us with significant additional opportunities to learn from community views on our project.

As part of our due diligence tasks within the EfW feasibility study, we have recently completed work on a Health Impact Assessment (HIA) for our project. This Assessment has now been finalised and we have agreed with the EPA that the report should now be shared through the Works Approval Application.

The EPA will review the HIA which will also be available for public comment through the Engage Victoria website.

We understand that submissions will be accepted by the EPA for two weeks. Submissions can be made through the [Engage Victoria website](#) and Australian Paper has also agreed with the EPA to extend the Works Approval Application which will now be completed by the 26th of October.

Thank you again for your interest in our Energy from Waste feasibility study and we look forward to continuing to gain valuable input to this project from our community.
